The Brooklyn Museum is pleased to announce the return of its annual Brooklyn Children's Book Fair on Sunday, November 12, from 11 am to 3:30 pm. This year is the largest in the fair's history, bringing together forty-one Brooklyn authors and illustrators to share their latest books. For the first time, the free event will have books in Mandarin, Hindi, and Spanish, plus a book celebrating Diwali, which falls on November 12 this year.

The fair features picture books, chapter books, and graphic novels—including works of fiction, nonfiction, and poetry—for book lovers from preschoolers through middle schoolers. Throughout the day, children and their companions can attend readings,

presentations, and a performance by The Band Books; learn about the creative process; get books signed; and participate in book-related art projects.
